Dolwyddelan Fishing Association was founded in the early 1940's, renting waters on the River Lledr between Dolwyddelan Village and Pont-y-Pant. The Association now own, or rent, both banks of the river from Dolwyddelan bridge to Pont-y-Pant bridge.

The river is predominantly salmon and sea trout, with the main salmon runs in August and September. The river was also stocked some years ago with brown trout, which are still in the river.

Local permits are available from the Secretary, Dave Foster at 17 Castle Terrace, Dolwyddelan (the former Post Office).
