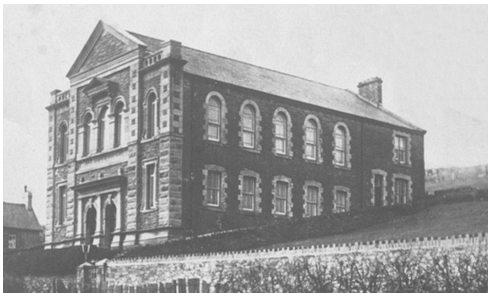
I would also like to thank the individuals who staff our polling stations, who carry out their work so diligently, always with a welcoming smile to greet electors.
