Ysgol Dolwyddelan are presently at Level 4 of the physical literacy programme and need to include the outdoor environment in their outdoor programme to achieve Level 5. This achievement is now within sight thanks to a boost to funds of £5000, donated by the members of St Gwyddelan's Church. Presently, only 5 schools in Conwy have achieved this desired status. Dolwyddelan is hot on their heels and is looking for match funding to turn their garden area at the rear of the school into a classroom space where the children can learn about bio-diversity and nature in action and thus achieve the desired next level. The space will also benefit the schools at Capel Garmon and Betws-y-Coed.

St Gwyddelan's Church was recently awarded the bronze Eco-Church status for its eco-management of their church and churchyard - the first church in Wales to do so- displaying further their commitment to the green agenda.
