Housing

The Council is in regular contact with various Agencies in Conwy County to discuss the situation regarding houses available to rent in this area and the possibility of having additional Affordable Houses in Dolwyddelan. We are aware that officials have visited the area to research and note possible sites for the building of additional Affordable Houses. Also a letter was distributed in the area recently by the Rural Housing Enabler Victoria Kelly on behalf of the Housing Group Cynefin, seeking information regarding people who need suitable affordable housing to buy or rent in this area.

The important message is that if you would like to rent a house in the Dolwyddelan area, be it a Council House or an Affordable House, then it is vital that you should register your interest with the Housing Options Team at Conwy. There are two reasons for this, it records your interest in getting a house, and by doing so it gives a clear indication to Agencies of the need for houses in the Dolwyddelan area.
