of August;

4. Conwy County Borough Council will be installing a telemetry system to monitor the watercourse in Tan Rallt road. This system will provide remote access and will inform us if there are any blockages, or if the water level is likely to create an imminent flood risk.

What Can I Do?

We ask all residents to remain vigilant to the risk of flooding. There are a number of potential sources of flood risk to the area:-

- 1. Surface water flowing down the fields above your property;
- 2. Surcharging of drainage systems as the volume of water exceeds their capacities;
- 3. Ground water entering properties via basements and also through foundations where there is no damp proof course

To manage these risks we ask all residents to consider property protection. The National Flood Forum is an independent charity setup to assist and advise communities at risk.
