## **GOOD TEMPLARISM**

A temperance meeting was also held at the Independent Chapel on Sunday afternoon where the same gentleman delivered a somewhat lengthy address. But generally, those who ought to have attended kept away.

## **Welsh Leek and Bacon Stuffing**

The taste will of course be improved greatly if Welsh bacon, butter and eggs are also used!

1oz (28g) butter

4oz (113g) smoked streaky bacon – de-rinded and finely chopped

1 ½ tsp mixed herbs

¼ tsp ground black pepper

1 stick celery – finely chopped

4oz (113g) leeks – trimmed and finely chopped

4oz (113g) fresh white breadcrumbs

1 egg – lightly beaten

Melt butter in pan. Add bacon and cook gently until starting to brown. Stir in herbs, pepper, celery and leeks. Cook gently for 1 minute. Mix in breadcrumbs and egg.

Use to stuff your turkey in the usual way, or cook in an ovenproof bowl and serve separately.
