

Cenotaph and Remembrance Garden

Work on the Cenotaph garden is completed, after unavoidable delays due to the Covid restrictions. Thirteen trees and six specimen shrubs have again been planted to commemorate the Dolwyddelan men who died fighting during the two world wars. This time they are Moonbeam Silver Birch trees, they are slow growing and can tolerate both dry, wet and exposed positions (ideal for Dolwyddelan). Shrubs have been planted between the trees, along with hundreds of spring bulbs.
