Conwy County Borough Council since 2019 have been encouraging Town and Community Council to take on ownership and responsibility for public toilets. Dolwyddelan Community Council took the initiative and are delighted that in July 2022 have now taken over ownership of the Public Conveniences in the village.

The Public Conveniences were in a poor condition and very outdated for the 21st Century. They are now environmentally friendly, sustainable, cost effective and comply to modern day standards, featuring as an added value asset to the village of Dolwyddelan. Being situated along the busy A470 Llandudno to Cardiff route they are well used by passing traffic, community, tourists and walkers alike.

Steve Teale who lives locally and the Facilities Manager at Conwy Council has been most supportive in driving this project forward and worked hand in hand with the Community Councillors on its design, lay out, colours etc etc. Partnership working imperative in achieving the objective.

There is also an addition of a water bottle re-fill station on the outside of the building, a floral hanging basket and the Dolwyddelan Community Council logo proudly displayed above the door.
