Bryn y Bedd Cemetery Update

Work carried out by Dolwyddelan Community Council is progressing nicely with the completion of Phase 2 of the renovation project at the Bryn y Bedd Cemetery. ALFA Tree Services removed all of the leylandii trees on the north side of the cemetery which has opened up



the site and made it brighter with lovely views of Moel Siabod. Daffodils will be planted this autumn and indigenous trees provided by the Snowdonia National Park Authority will be supplied to complete Ph. 2. Phase 3 is underway with a grant received from The European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development, through a CCBC Wales Rural Community Development Grant. This phase focuses on the repair of the four wrought iron benches, the iron gates, the gate pillars, part of the cemetery wall, and refreshing the two slate plaques. The Dolwyddelan Community Council look forward to this phase being completed at the end of the year.
