The consultation will look to understand the current community, focusing on existing strengths and assets that can be built on, whilst identifying risks and limitations that need to be addressed. The feasibility study for the Bethel Chapel social enterprise will then incorporate the findings from the consultation to determine if the creation of an open daily, fully accessible community space, is financially viable and sustainable, and how the risks and limitations to current community activities can be addressed.

To really understand and get a holistic view of how best to support our community, we need everyone to participate in and engage with the community consultation, all views are welcome.
