PONT RUFEGINIG (ROMAN BRIDGE) COMMEMORATION OF WWII U.S. SOLDIERS.

As next year will be the 80th anniversary of D-Day, Dolwyddelan Historical Society are involved in a project to site a noticeboard, overlooking the field, where in June 1944, the soldiers of the 83rd Infantry Division, American Army camped, during ground manoeuvres, ahead of them taking part in the allied invasion of Europe.

The noticeboard will tell the story of how the camp was flooded out due to heavy rainfall, and the onward journey of the brave men, who, only days after leaving Dolwyddelan, found themselves in deadly armed combat with the opposing forces.
