As you all know, Conwy County Borough Council have stopped distributing the collection calendars. There is a copy of the calendar in the noticeboard on the old bus stop and the calendar is also available on the Conwy Council website, to download and print out, or you can download the app from the council website Resident>Recycling and Waste>The Conwy App. This will send out a reminder each Tuesday evening of what is being collected the next day. If you don't want the app you can just bookmark this page. If you tell it to remember your address in future, the bookmark will take you straight to your collection.
