### August 3<sup>rd</sup> 1906 – North Wales Weekly News

In the Vale of Conwy, rain poured down incessantly for about ten hours, with the result that the river Conwy by midday yesterday, had inundated the neighbouring meadows. Hundreds of acres were covered and in the vicinity of Dolyddelen there was a pitiable spectacle. Large fields of hay were completely submerged, and in the early hours of the morning farmers would be seen wading knee-deep in the hope of saving their hay which was still out. Other crops, as well as property had been considerably damaged many sheep having perished.
