**FLOOD PLAN -** In the development of the Conwy Valley Multi Agency Flood plan, communities that are known to flood, such as Dolwyddelan, are encouraged to respond by producing a local flood plan. The Dolwyddelan Community Council and Cllr Liz Roberts who is a member of the multi agency partnership are engaging with Dwr Cymru and Natural Resources Wales in producing this local plan.

The endeavour is, for volunteers to work alongside the Dolwyddelan Community Council in ensuring our residents in the village receive advance notice from NRW of a possible flood event locally.

Two volunteers is the request but up to 5 persons would be ideal. Cllr Liz and the Clerk of Dolwyddelan Community Council are willing to support the volunteers in coordinating such a scheme for Dolwyddelan with the support also of Dwr Cymru and NRW.

New picnic benches have been installed in the station woodland area and another by the swings.

COMMUNITY PLAN - A successful couple of events took place at the Pavilion with residents sharing their thoughts. Dolwyddelan Community Council is now awaiting the completed Plan from the consultant so it can be shared with the community.
